September 2018: Pedestrianised Carpark at the end of the day.

In the new academic year, we will be making the carpark area a pedestrian only area during the times of 2:45pm and 3:30pm. There will be no vehicular access or exit between these times to enable parents and children to safely exit the premises on foot.
