Our Zone Board

Understanding how our zone board works is really helpful for you as parents so we have created a Parent Guide for you.

When the behaviour team spoke to pupils and staff and parents in the Summer Term, one thing that came out clearly was a desire to keep standards really high and consistent across the whole school.

Our motto during our training days at the beginning of term was 'last year's gold is this year's silver!' We want that sense of raising standards to be in all every area of the school, We're proud to be at Coleshill and we're aiming high.

We are currently completing our updated behaviour policy which will be available soon on our website and replace the existing policy.

Gold

Exceptional learning behaviours for the individual – *EVERY* child has the opportunity to get on gold

Key Rewards - gold sticker, first choice of 'Me Time', a gold lanyard which gives you special privileges (see behaviour policy for full list).

Silver

Going **above and beyond** in their learning behaviours. Reward – silver sticker, second in line for choice of 'Me Time'.

Green

Meeting behaviour goals in their conduct and learning behaviour; working hard and doing what is expected of them. Reward – 'Me Time' a choice of a variety of fun activities at the end of the week.

Amber

A warning that their conduct or learning behaviour is not meeting our behaviour goals and a reminder to 'get back on green' Consequence – 5 minutes of 'Me Time' lost

Red

Continued poor learning behaviours or conduct, or non-tolerable actions (see behaviour policy). A warning that their conduct or learning behaviour is not meeting our agreed behaviour goals Consequence – 10 minutes of 'Me Time' lost.

If your child goes onto the red zone you will always be contacted by a member of staff. First red – Classteacher; second red of week – Phase Leader; third red in a week – Deputy or Headteacher.

At Coleshill we love dogs, ball games, scooters and bikes. It is always good to see our children being active on the way to school; walking, cycling and using their scooters.



However please remember that pets, ball games and scooters are not permitted on the school playgrounds before or after school.

Please place scooters/bikes in the shelter provided before entering the playground. Thank you for your consideration and help in this matter.
