Important News About School Meals

The school's Board of Governors are currently discussing a growing concern regarding the amount of money owed to the school by parents. This includes nursery fees, music tuition, school trips and school meals; much of this dating back over two years.

Our policies and processes are being reviewed, and in the new year new systems will be put in place to help parents avoid getting into debt. For those paying for school meals, this will include a fixed limit on arrears for dinner money and the withdrawal of the school meal option whilst the account is in arrears.

In the past, despite being administered with the best intentions, school practices have allowed parents to accumulate a range of debts which can then become unmanageable. Governors want to ensure we help prevent this in the future and have effective ways of recovering money owed.

We are always happy to discuss options to help families who may be experiencing difficulties, and would encourage all parents to check their eligibility for Pupil Pre-

mium. This provides additional funding for the school and also entitles the child to a free school meal, which is a significant financial benefit worth £11.00 per week to a child in KS2 and beyond into senior school. You can apply easily online - please visit

www.warwickshire.gov.uk/freesch oolmeals to check your eligibility. Claims cannot be backdated, so please apply sooner rather than later, even if your child is in Reception/KS1.

Look out for news about our new policies coming soon, but in the meantime, please can all parents check their ParentPay accounts and ensure any outstanding money is cleared.
