## **New Positive Attendance Scheme**

In the New Year we will be launching a new scheme to help raise the profile of the importance of good attendance. As I have shared in previous newsletters, attendance at Coleshill has been below national averages for some time and it is an area the Governing Board and I am keen to see improve.

Previously, excellent whole class attendance was recognised and rewarded however this could mean children with outstanding

attendance who were in a class which had not such good average attendance missed out.

In the New Year we will begin a prize draw at the end of each term. Children will enter the draw every time they complete one week of full attendance. On Monday mornings children will gain a raffle ticket in the draw if they had 100% attendance the week before. Therefore a child who has 100% attendance for the whole term will have 12-15 tickets in the draw

(depending on the length of the term).

However, every child gets a chance to be part of it. If a child is unfortunate and needs to have some time off due to illness, by the very next Monday they'll have a new chance to work towards that next ticket.

The prizes will reflect just how important we know good attendance is, with the first prize at the end of the Spring Term being a choice from a selection of new bikes.

#### **Last Day of Term**

Part of the last day will be a toys and games hour. Children are invited to bring in a toy/ game that they would like to play with their classmates.

Board games, card games or action figures are welcome. Please **no electronics** and ensure toys/games are named so they find their way home!

School closes at 2:00pm on 21st Dec.

### **Outstanding balances for School Dinners**
