# SLIGHT CHANGES TO MORNINGS

Along with the opening of the new classroom, we are also slightly altering places to wait in the morning. All times remain the same. However, from Monday 11th March;

- Both Reception classes and Y1J may walk through and wait on the reception playground
- KS2 children must congregate on the Y3/4 playground only
- Both Y2 classes and Y1B should congregate on the usual main playground. (On Monday, prior to handover, Y1B will enter the school through the Y3 corridor entrance under the new canópy—A member of staff will be there to assist.

This will allow all parents and children some areas of shelter in poor weather.

Also, we will trial re-opening the upper gate near the Nursery entrance to attempt to reduce the bottle neck at the single pedestrian entrance gate.

Please ensure that you continue to use George's crossing point even if you are using this second gate. One of the reasons for closure was to encourage good habits in crossing which have improved.

We will be looking at other options regarding entry to the site over the next months to further improve access now we have nearly 450 children attending school and preschool each day.

## TIMES TABLES ROCKSTARS IS HERE!


