## MEDALS FOR OUR TENNIS FINALISTS

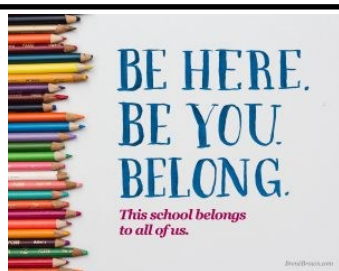

Class 3R will be swimming next week.

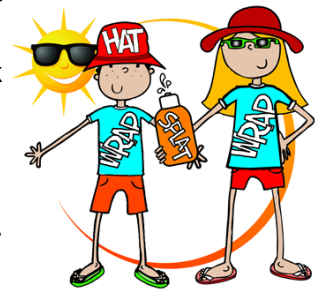
