Changes to Mornings

We constantly review the safety of children in and around the school and as part of this monitoring we have been looking at site security in the mornings.

To further develop safety for our children, as from Monday 23rd April the gate to the main playground will remain locked until 8:30am. Access to Breakfast Club will be via the main entrance (please use the doorbell provided so that a member of staff can let you in).

A member of staff will open the main gates at 8:30am. KS2 children without parent supervision will then gather on the far reception playgrounds where a member of staff will be present.

Reception and KS1 parents who have arrived before doors open at 8:45am will gather on the main KS2 playground until doors open. Once doors have opened then reception parents may make their way round to their children's classrooms.

There will be no ball games before school as we are not able to accommodate for unsupervised children gathering before the school gates open. Children without parental supervision should not arrive at school before 8:30am.

I appreciate your patience and understanding as we trial this improvement to safety.
