According to Public Health England a quarter of 5 year olds have tooth decay with an average of 3 or 4 teeth being affected. This leads to around 60,000 missed school days a year and causes problems with eating and sleeping. Children's tooth extractions are also one of the largest causes of hospital admissions in the UK.

It is recommended that you supervise your child/children cleaning their teeth at night and one other time. Ensure your child/children are registered with a dentist and visit the dentist every

6 months for a check-up (this is a free service for children under 18 years).

It takes an average of 40 minutes for the mouth to neutralise the acid caused by eating or drinking sugar. Therefore it is best to wait at least one hour after eating before brushing teeth. For more information go to;
