Before and After School reminders.

The playground gates are opened at 8.30am when children and adults can come on to the site to wait until the classroom doors are open at 8.45am. School Registers will not be taken until 8.55am. This is so that children have plenty of time to get to their classes even when the doors have been opened.



- **No dogs on site:** A reminder to parents and carers that dogs are NOT allowed on site even very small dogs 'in arms'. We have had incidents of dogs fouling around school which then can be trodden into the classrooms and some children are genuinely frightened of animals.



Where should I go?

- Children in **Reception** and **Miss Wittering's** class can walk round to the infant playground with their adult once the main playground gate is open at 8:30am.
- **Mrs Owen's** children and parents along with **Year 2** children and adults should wait on the large rectangular playground until the school doors open at 8:45am.
- Children who come to school without an adult in **year 3,4,5** and **6** should assemble on the middle playground. They will be supervised from 8.35am by school staff.
- If your child in **years 3,4,5** or **6** wants you to stay with them please remain on the rectangular playground until the whistle goes at 8.45am.

Please help us ensure mornings are calm and safe for everyone by encouraging your children to follow our long standing rules;

- No children on the field or the Trim Trail before school
- No ball games before school
- Scooters and bikes to be stored in the shelter
- Park with consideration for our neighbours

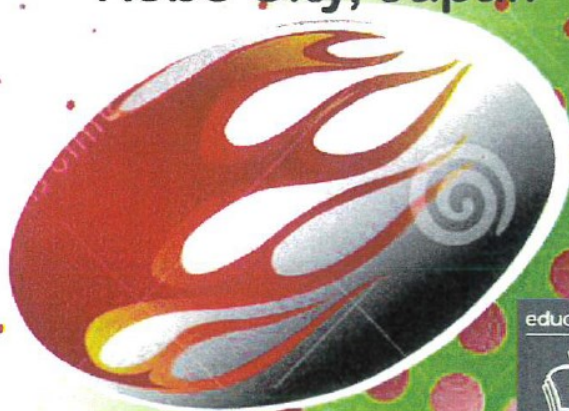
