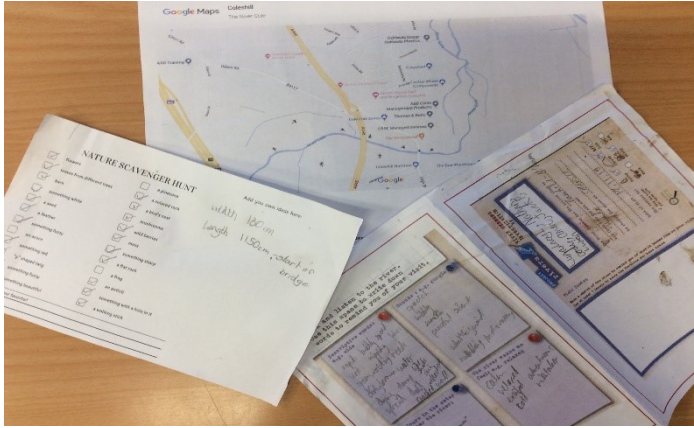


Y5 Visit to our local river: The River Cole, 13th November

Measurements of local stream: depth, width, speed of flow.

Measurements taken will be used to create a profile of the cross section explored.

Record a visual representation of the wildlife and habitats observed at the local stream.





We took measurements of depth, width and velocity (speed of water).

We noticed the wildlife and environment which included an apple tree with fallen apples – some were ripe some were rotting. We made sketches of the aspects which interested us.

Nathan noticed the strength of the water by how hard it was pushing on his wellies.

We discussed the safety of water and, despite being good swimmers, how dangerous rivers are because of the strength of the current and the coldness of the water affecting how our muscles work.

Boys/Girls (4-7s) - games, books, cars, trucks, dolls, jewellery.

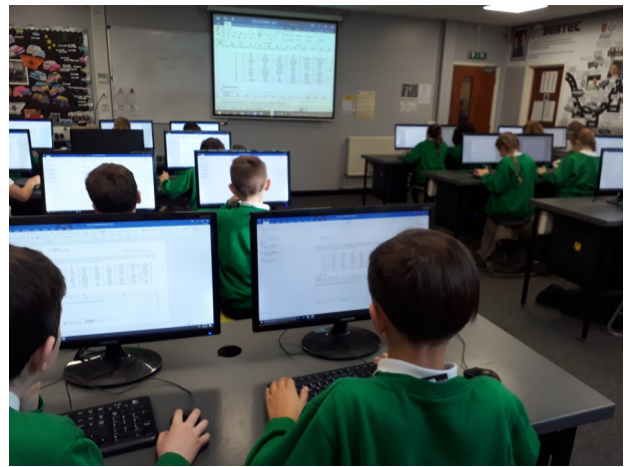
Boys/Girls (8-10s) - games, hats, gloves, suitable toiletries, books, annuals (dated for the coming year).

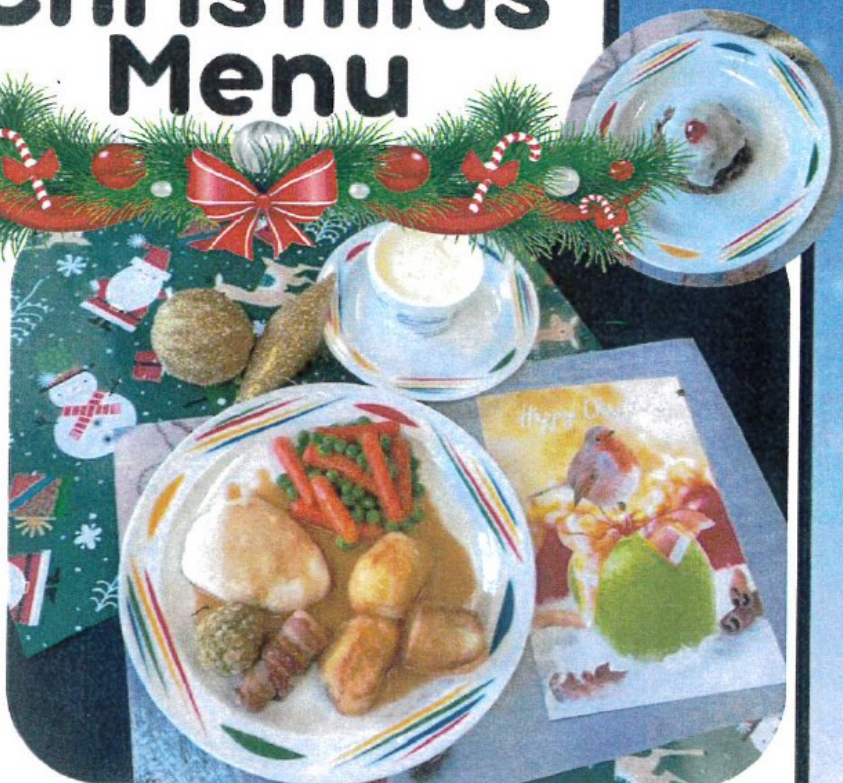
