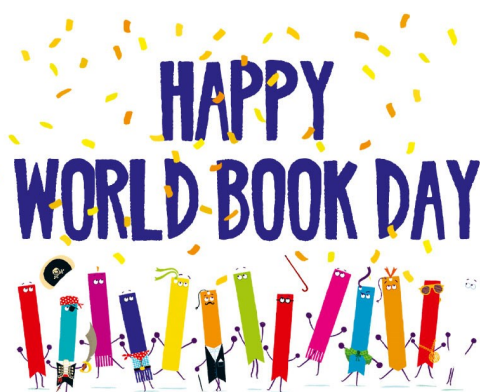

Next week it will be Mrs Prince's class to go swimming and we will be on Week 2 of the dinner menu.

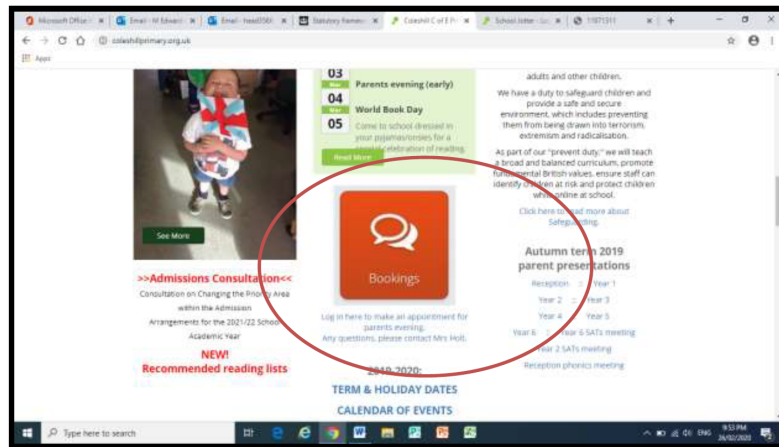
