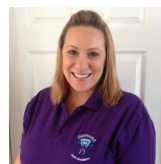

The children had an amazing experience, seeing someone within our own school community who has had such an illustrious past. Children got to try on Sarah's Medals (the real ones!), watch footage of an important medal winning race, walk a 'Queen's Baton' around the hall and hear what life is like for an elite athlete.

Stone age art in Year 3

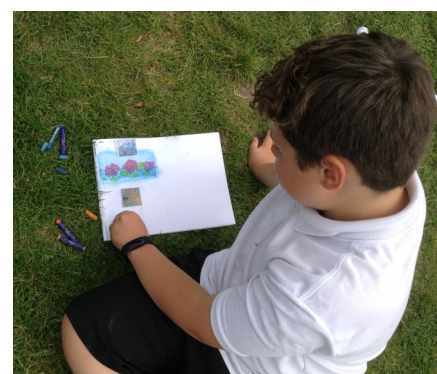
